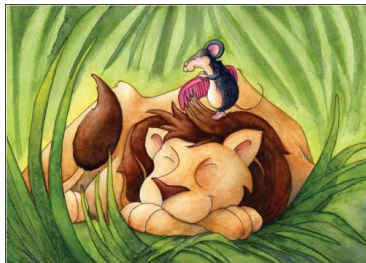
### Straight from the Heart
