The church webpage is still ever growing. A new Feed the Faith page has been added to the mix. This page, though not

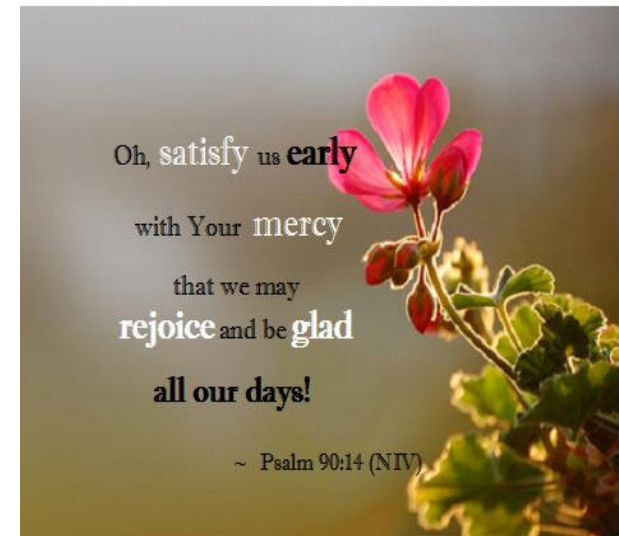
