What's New?

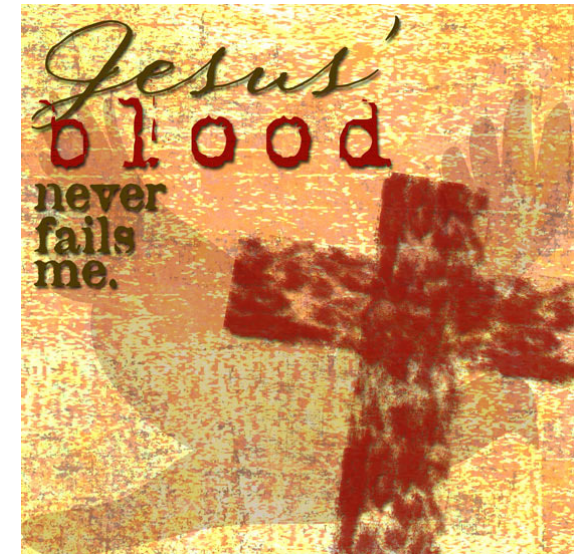
