Four truths about Revelation

**1. The Central person is Jesus.**

- a. We're not looking for something to happen; we are looking for someone to come!
- b. Jesus is the theme of the Bible.
- c. The book of Revelation is the glory of Jesus unveiled.

**2. The Purpose of the book(vs.1)**

- a. To show Servants the things, which shortly will take place.
  - i. A Bond-Servant is a person who chooses to be a slave of the person who sets him free out of love and devotion for that person. Christ sets us free. We choose to serve Him.
- b. Satan does NOT know the future

**3. The Promise of the Book(vs.3)**

- a. It is the one book that says it is a Blessing.
- b. Read it, Hear it, and Keep it!
- c. If you Read it, hear it, and keep it, you will want to see the lost saved.
- d. Rev. 11:15 – Christ shall reign
- e. Rev. 21:4 – No more death, pain, sorrow, or crying
- f. Rev. 1:8 – Christ is the beginning and end
- g. Stability



**4. It Is a Prophecy(vs.3)**

- a. The time is at hand for His return.
- b. Jesus is coming; therefore, we should be watching and waiting readily.
  - i. 1 Peter 4:7 – Be ready and in prayer
  - ii. 1 Cor. 10:11 – These things are written to prepare us for the end of days.
  - iii. Php 4:5 - The Lord is at Hand
  - iv. James 5:8 – Be patient. He's coming.
  - v. 1 John 2:18 – We know it's the end of days. Anti-Christ's are here.
- c. It will come swiftly
  - i. 1 Thess 5:2 – He will come as a thief in the night
